SNOWBOARDING SKILL LEVELS



- Level 1 ● Your first time on a snowboard.
- Level 2 ● You are able to use the lifts; you perform skidded traverse on easiest **Green** terrain using both heel and toe sides; you can stop.
- Level 3 ● You are able to perform skidded traverse and garlands in both directions with confidence and control on **Green** terrain.
- Level 4 ●■ You are able to link turns in both directions with speed control on all **Green** and some easier **Blue** terrain.
- Level 5 ■ You are able to link skidded turns showing rhythm with no traverse on either heel or toe sides on all **Green** and easier **Blue** terrain.
- Level 6 ■ You are confident on most **Blue** terrain and are beginning to carve turns.
- Level 7 ■◆ You are able to carve turns on all **Blue** terrain and the easier **Black** terrain.
- Level 8 ◆ You are able to carve turns with efficient riding under all terrain and snow conditions.
- Level 9 ◆◆ Nothing bothers you. Enjoy your day at Catamount!!

SKIING SKILL LEVELS



Level 1 **Beginner** - Your first time on skis or you are unable to stop.

Level 2 **Type 1/Novice** - You are able to maintain a wedge (pie or "A" shape), but you have trouble stopping and changing direction. You have not skied much or often.

Level 3 ● You can make wedge turns from the top of the Beginner slope and you can stop. You are ready for the chairlift and advance to **Green** terrain. You have skied a little.

Level 4 ● You make controlled wedge turns on **Green** terrain and sometimes your skis are parallel at the end of the turn. You ski most of the **Green** terrain.

Level 5 ●■ **Type 2/Intermediate** - Most of your turn is parallel. You have almost completely lost the wedge. You confidently ski all **Green** and some **Blue** terrain.

Level 6 ■ You ski most of the time on **Blue** terrain and the majority of your turns and skiing are parallel.

Level 7 ■◆ You are skiing all **Blue** terrain and the easier **Black** terrain with parallel turns and using pole plants and showing speed control.

Level 8 ◆ You are able to exhibit dynamic parallel turns on varied conditions including carved medium and long radius turns.

Level 9 ◆ **Type 3/Advanced** - You ski comfortably on all terrain and under all conditions showing dynamic parallel turns. You are exploring bumps and gates.

Level 10 ◆◆ Nothing bothers you. Enjoy your day at Catamount!!

GROUP ADVANT-EDGE PROGRAM

PROGRAM RULES & POLICIES

DURATION - The Catamount Group Advant-edge Program provides each participant with a four(4) hour on-mountain pass which is valid for a predefined number of weeks{usually six(6)}starting in January as designated by the group's organizer. **No program sessions are conducted during the February President's Day vacation week.**

- **REFUNDS & MAKE-UPS** - While make-ups will be organized for entire groups where circumstances warrant, there are **NO REFUNDS OR INDIVIDUAL MAKE-UPS** permitted under this program for any reason.
 - **ELIGIBILITY** - A group member under this program must be a minimum of six (6) years of age with the ability to ride a ski lift after receiving applicable instruction in order to participate.
 - **LESSONS** - If a participant is including lessons in their program, we ask you to select a **LESSON TYPE** (*skiing or snowboarding. No snowblades or skiboards at this time.*) and **ABILITY LEVEL**(*refer to attached charts*). This will only be used as a guide; all participants will be assessed by the instructional staff at the time of the first lesson.
 - **SUBMISSION** - This Sign-up Form together with the appropriate payment (see front) must be submitted to your group organizer no later than **November 1st** to avoid incurring a late fee of \$10.

PROGRAM - LIABILITY RELEASE FORM - TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please read carefully before completing and signing.

1. I acknowledge that skiing and snowboarding, like many other sports, contains inherent risks including but not limited to the risks of personal injury, death or property damage which may be caused by variations in terrain or weather conditions, surface or sub-surface snow, ice, bare spots or areas of thin cover, moguls, ruts, bumps, other persons using the facilities, rocks, forest growth, debris, branches, trees, roots, stumps or other natural objects or man-made objects that are incidental to the provision and/or maintenance of a Snowsports facility in the states of New York and Massachusetts. In this regard, I agree to be bound by the provisions of Mass. G. L., Ch 143, Sec 71P or NYS Gen Obligations Law, Article 18, as applicable.
2. I agree that any claims that I may bring against the RELEASEES shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the courts of either Berkshire County, Massachusetts or Columbia County, New York and that no claims against the RELEASEES shall be brought in any other jurisdiction.
3. I understand that an on-mountain pass will be issued to the participant named herein, valid for the duration of the program. I further understand that a fee of \$5 will be charged in respect of a forgotten pass (one forgotten pass will be permitted) and a fee of \$30 will be charged for the issue of a replacement pass.
4. I understand that the participant's on-mountain privileges may be revoked for 1. Vandalism, theft or destruction of property owned by Catamount or others; 2. Use or sale of prohibited or restricted substances or alcohol on the Catamount property; 3. Selling, transferring or loaning of an on-mountain pass of any description; 4. Reckless behavior of any description on or off the mountain, 5. Entering or using closed trails and areas; 6. Misuse of on-mountain lifts or 7. Misuse of the on-mountain permit.
5. I hereby certify that **all information** submitted on this form is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
6. I acknowledge that the Catamount Group Advant-edge Program is a pre-paid program. I further acknowledge and agree to pay the full cost of my participant's enrolment in this program in the amount of \$ (as calculated on back). I have provided my preferred payment method and information on back.
7. I have carefully read the Rules, Policies, Terms and Conditions of this program and agree to be bound by the same.
