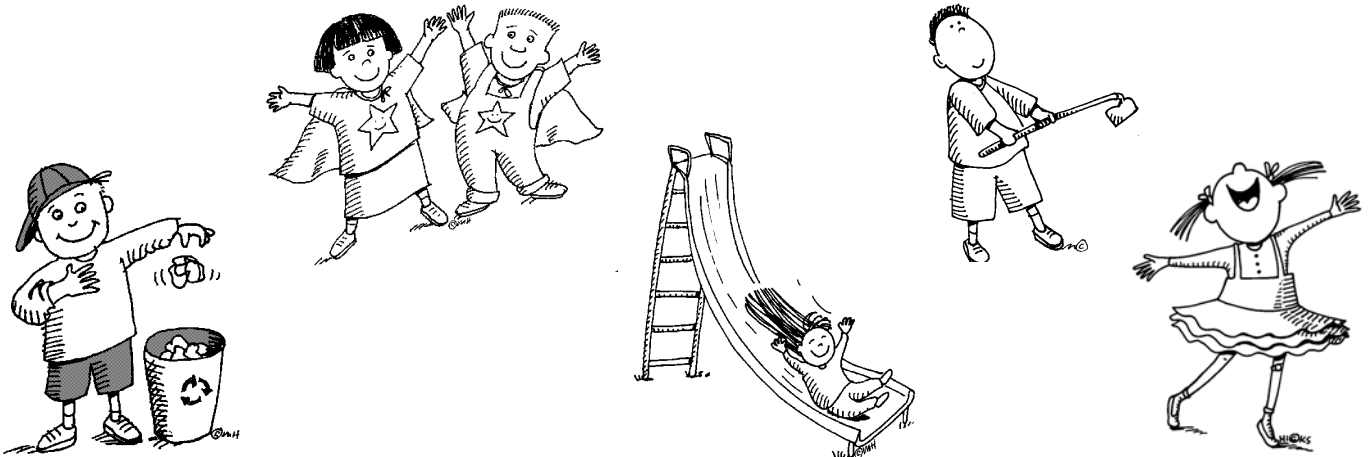

Classes

Lego Building (grades K-5)

We believe that after school time should be a happy blend of instruction and play in a safe and familiar environment. This is not an extension of the school day. The program will provide an opportunity to enrich students and eliminate the inconvenience of driving children to a variety of locations for lessons. A snack will be provided for all enrolled students.

Calendar

After school at DDS will follow the DDS school calendar. This program will run concurrently with our upper school after-school athletic program. Snacks will be provided from 3:10 to 3:30 and classes will run from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. When school is not in session or is in session for only half a day, the program will not meet.

After School Studyhall

After school studyhall will be available to all students and is held in the DDS library. This time will give your child the opportunity to work on homework, get together with classmates for group projects or to just simply read a book. For those students who do not have homework or have finished with their work, there will be crayons, markers, paper and several board games available to use. A snack will be provided for all students. Although we prefer that you sign up ahead of time, it is not required. You may send a note in with your child the day you would like them to stay or in emergencies, you may call the office and leave a message. The fee will be \$12.50 per session and you can register your child for one or both classes. Attendance will be taken each day and you will be billed at the end of each month. Pickup is at the glass doors where morning drop-off occurs. If students have participated in a class we will bring them out to the cars when the class is over. Parents of students staying in study hall need to come in and sign for their children.

Registration

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment must accompany the registration form in order to secure a place in the class (some financial aid is available). Because class size is limited, prompt registration is recommended. Please complete a separate form for each child and return it to Jean Cook with a check payable to DDS.

No refunds will be made after classes begin and there will be no discounts for absences. DDS reserves the right to cancel any class for which there is insufficient enrollment. Please direct any questions to Jean Cook at 677-5014 x28.
